Ferdinand Porsche FernFH was the only Austrian University of Applied Sciences to be awarded the state prize for "Family & Career". In the "private commercial enterprises with 21-100 employees" category, the FernFH achieved 3rd place behind Hubmann Bau GmbH (Styria) and Müller Bau GmbH & Co KG (Vorarlberg).

The "Family & Career" state prize honours Austrian companies and institutions for particularly outstanding achievements in the field of family-conscious personnel policy in various categories. There was a total of 68 entries from seven federal states. Ferdinand Porsche FernFH was able to demonstrate its family-friendliness with measures such as flexible working hours, mobile working at the three locations, working from home, a special bring-your-pet policy and the option of taking the children to the office, which is particularly relevant during school holidays. With this, FernFH was able to reach 3rd place in the "private commercial enterprises with 21-100 employees" category and asserted itself as a unique University of Applied Sciences against fierce competition.

Axel Jungwirth, CEO of FernFH couldn't be prouder: "I'm so proud of our University of Applied Sciences and of getting third place. It shows that a company doesn't have to compromise on family-friendliness in order to achieve strong growth. The well-being of my employees is my top priority. This is why it's important that we make it possible that family time, free time and a career are in harmony with one another. We offer flexibility not only to our students, but also to our employees".
